


We are called as Christ-followers to bear and share a song of peace on our lips to a world that is weary. We are called as disciples to share the love of Christ through our hands and feet.

Advent Book Study
Faithful: Christmas Through the Eyes of Joseph, by Adam Hamilton

From his beginnings as a humble carpenter to his all-important role as the earthly father of Jesus Christ, Joseph's place in the nativity story is sometimes overlooked but contains valuable lessons for all of us.

In this study, we will examine Christmas through the eyes of Joseph, a man who is absent from much of the biblical narrative. He never spoke a word, but his courageous actions were crucial to the birth of Christ and God's salvation plan for humanity.

We will discover how Joseph's story is much like our own. In life, we encounter circumstances that we would never have chosen for ourselves. At times it can be tempting to simply walk away. Joseph provides us a great example of humbly obeying God, even when we don't understand, and faithfully moving forward in the strength that God provides.

This four week study will take place each Sunday in Advent (December 1, 8, 15, and 22). We will meet at 7:00 pm via Zoom.

Books are \$12/each, and will be ordered the week before Thanksgiving.
