

Good News

This month's newsletter is coming out a few days later than normal, and that is my fault. To be honest, it has been difficult to pull together the words for this letter, and that is the reason for the delay.

The words have been hard to come by... for we are in extraordinary times of instability and uncertainty.

Over the weekend, by all definitions of the word, we experienced a coup in our nation, and now the richest man on the planet (indeed, in all of history) now controls access to government finances and sensitive data on millions of us. Our national security is in doubt and at risk.

Over the weekend, a senseless trade war was begun by our president with our two geographic neighbors. Prices on everyday goods and necessities are going to skyrocket. The stock market is already reeling.

Over the weekend, videos and stories continued to emerge of the horrific roundups of migrants, immigrants, and refugees around the nation. A detention center is being planned for Guantanamo Bay, eerily reminiscent of the concentration camps of the third reich.

If you feel overwhelmed and reeling, you are not alone.

The sad truth is, things are probably going to get worse before they get better. And yet... **our commitment to each other is stronger than their allegiance to wealth and power.**

You may ask, what are we going to do differently in the face of these destructive forces?

In short, nothing. We are not going to do anything differently. We are going to continue to seek after God's justice... we are going to continue to be passionate lovers of what is kind in this world... we are going to continue walking humbly with our God.

The longer answer is more complicated. Because this moment calls for us to step up and step forward and add our voices to the chorus of those who demand an end to the racist attacks and damaging policies that are active in our world.

And the deeper truth is this: what has been exposed is the reality that all of the institutions we have relied on for so long have been functioning in damaging ways for a long time.

1 Corinthians chapter 13 is one we typically hear at weddings. It's all about love, after all. But I think we need this chapter now more than ever. It is a reminder of what love looks like, sounds like, and feels like. There are many who are professing to speak for Christ, yet are preaching a warped vision of the Gospel. This Christian Nationalist faith must be called out for what it is: blasphemy. It is rooted not in love, as Paul calls us to, but in fear and greed.

Our love, and the love of God in Christ, is so much stronger than fear. It is so much more powerful than greed.

In the book of Revelation, John is given a vision of the new heaven and the new earth. It is a place that is rich in its diversity, thrives in its inclusion of all people, and grows in love because of the equity found there. This is the kin-dom we are working toward.

May our vision be clear, our courage unwavering, and our love shine forth as we continue to be the hands and feet of Christ in God's very good creation. Grace & peace,




